
Media Personnel Visit






Development Work in a Glimpse



Work under Short Term Development Plan commenced in May - June 2012 and is expected to complete in 2018. Sector 3, 5, 6 and 7 will be developed under this plan. Short Term Development Plan comprises of the following projects:


- Sector Development Works, including road works, water supply network, sewerage network, storm water drainage network, hydraulic structures like culverts, guard room, ICT pipe sleeves, electricity pipe sleeves, gas pipe sleeves and landscaping.
- Major Water Works
- Major Sewerage Works

- Major Electricity/ICT/Gas Works
- Major Housing Works

Defence Housing Authority (DHA) signed a contract with Pakistan Telecommunication Company Ltd. (PTCL) on November 28, 2013, for the initiation of Information Communication Technology (ICT) works for making DHA City Karachi (DCK) the first-ever 'Smart City' of the country.

The project developers will focus on power generation and aim for consumption of at least 30 percent renewable energy. PTCL president and CEO Waleed Irshad said that the road map of the ICT was based on optical fiber and that DCK will have modern communication and information facilities.
